Two Auden Songs for high voice and piano (2007)

2007, being WH Auden's centenary, saw plenty of Auden celebrations and projects. The soprano Eleanor Meynell led one such successful project, commissioning a number of composers; for Eleanor, I set Auden's perennial love poem, *Lullaby*.

Another fruitful collaboration for me that year was working with James Gilchrist on the premiere of my scena 'Alkman the Choirmaster', to words by the poet John Fuller (who is also, a leading authority on Auden).

It followed naturally to make a companion setting for *Lullaby* and dedicate it to James. I chose Auden's sonnet honouring Edward Lear; it's a remarkable poem, capturing many of the elements of Lear's life. Loneliness, travels, painting and the surreal fantasy of Lear's poetic imagination are all there.
